We are located at 4250 Haliburton Lake Road, Haliburton, ON Radio the office and Director using the closest walkie-talkie. Send a responsible runner to the Health Centre to personally advise the medical staff of the situation.
Transport child to hospital immediately even if symptoms subside, accompanied by a staff member ❖ Send any additional medication with the camper in the ambulance
A member of the Leadership Team [including medical staff] will call the parents/guardians or emergency contacts.
